Maharashtra under Targeted Public Distribution System (TPDS) for the year
2012-13 - reg.

Sir,

I am directed to say that the following monthly quantities of foodgrains have been
allocated to your State/UT for AAY, BPL and APL families, under TPDS, for the period from
April 2012 to March 2013:

2. The Validity period for lifting of these allocations will be fifty (50) days for each
allocation month separately, starting from the first day of the month preceding the
allocation month and ending on the 20th day of the allocation month. *As regards the
allocation for the month of April 2012, period of 50 days shall be computed from the
date of issue of this letter.* It will be mandatory for State and UT Governments to deposit
the cost of foodgrains to FCI latest by 15th of each allocation month (crediting the amount
to the FCI account). However, lifting of foodgrains in instalments against allocations
within the validity period will be allowed. **Detailed instructions on extension of validity
for deposit of cost and lifting of foodgrains under TPDS have already been issued
vide this Department's letter No.1-2/2007-BP-III BP-III dated 27th June, 2011.**

3. The rice allocated under TPDS should be distributed in the form of whole grains.
However, the wheat allocated may be distributed as wheat flour/atta or fortified wheat
flour/atta through the network of fair price shops to AAY, BPL & APL categories of card
holders under the TPDS, subject to the terms and conditions as laid down in this
Department's letter No.4-7/2005-Py.IV/PD.I(Pt.) dated 17th January, 2008 as modified
from time to time.



The foodgrains allocated under TPDS should be utilized only for the purpose for which the same have been allocated and not for any other purpose/scheme. **This is in consonance with the Utilization Certificate which is required to be regularly furnished by your State/UT under the PDS Control Order, 2001 on mandatory basis.**
