Subject:-Allocation of 43241.220 tons of food grains (Wheat/ Rice) at BPL rates under Annapurna Scheme for the year 2015-16 to the beneficiaries in the States/UTs namely, Andhra Pradesh, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Goa, Himachal Pradesh, Jharkhand, Kerala, Maharashtra, Odisha, Tamil Nadu, Telangana, West Bengal, Assam, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Sikkim, Tripura, A&N Island and D&N Haveli for six months of 2015-16, i.e. from April, 2015 to September, 2015.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to OM No.4-5/2015-BP-II(Annapurna) dated 12th August, 2015 of the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Department of Food and Public Distribution on the above mentioned subject and to convey the approval of the Ministry for allocation of 43241.220 tons of food grains comprising 32743.620 tons of rice and 10497.600 tons of wheat for the year 2015-16 at central issue price(C IP) applicable for Below Poverty Line (BPL) families under Annapurna Scheme. 2. The validity period for the lifting of food grains and depositing of cost will be upto 30.9.2015.
3. The food grains allocated under Annapurna scheme should be utilized only for the purpose for which the same have been allocated and not for any other purpose/ scheme. The monitoring and implementation of the distribution of subsidized food grains under the programme will be the responsibility of the concerned State Government. The food grains under the scheme must be distributed by the State Government through Fair Price Shops.
4. Food Corporation of India(FCI) will issue rice/wheat as per State-wise allocation for the year 2015-16 with to the nominees of the State Government as per district-wise sub allocation to be made by the State Government on pre-payment of the cost of food grains at BPL price from its nearest go downs/ depots.
5. FCI may accordingly give suitable instructions to its concerned Regional Offices under intimation to this Ministry.
6. Further allocation for next 6 months from October 2015 to March 2016 of the financial year 2015-16 onwards under the scheme will be considered only on receipt of proper Utilization Certificates from the States/UTs in respect of food grains allocated for the 2014-15 and 2015-2016.
