I am directed to state that the Government of India has sanctioned allocation of Kerosene. The companywise allocation for the month of April, 2016 is as shown below :-



2. The Companywise and districtwise allocation of kerosene for the month of **May, 2016** is shown in the appended statement . The Oil Companies are requested to strictly ensure that the districts are supplied the quantity shown against each company in the accompanying statement for May, 2016. They should also ensure that maximum 85% of the total allocation of kerosene is released during the first fortnight and the lifting should be on prorata basis so that the quota released will be uniform throughout the state during each fortnight of the said months and even at the last day kerosene will be available for domestic users.

3. The Oil Companies are also requested to collect the monthly information regarding dealerwise allocation from the respective Collector/Controller of Rationing

& Director of Civil Supplies, Mumbai. After obtaining the monthly information, the dealerwise allocation should be immediately informed to the concerned shipping locations for release of kerosene to the dealers.
